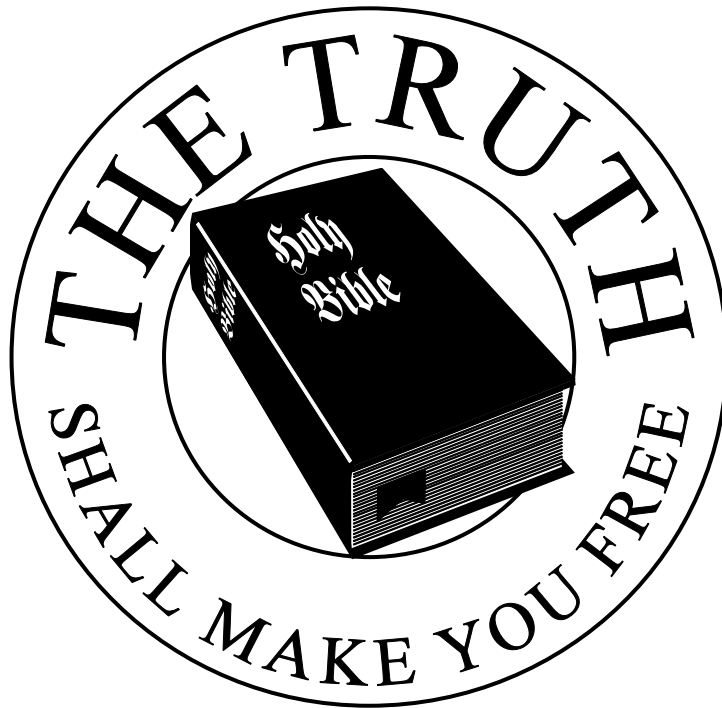




# TRINITY RESCUE MISSION LIFELINE PROGRAM

# LIFELINE PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

## **LEVEL- 1 Program Orientation**

*Objective:* To understand and identify with the mission of the Trinity Rescue Mission and the Lifeline Program. To display a sincere commitment to live with respect for myself, the mission, and the other men in the program.

*Assignments:* Complete and submit a Biblical Problem Solving Worksheet. Complete daily work assignments with diligence, cooperation, and a positive attitude. Properly complete Devotional Guides daily, become familiar with Renewal Prayer and Statements of Truth. Schedule an orientation session.

*Requirements:* Stay free from alcohol, drugs, tobacco and ungodly conversation. Obey the general rules of the mission and the supervisors and counselors that have authority over you. Display a humble attitude when faced with problems or conflicts and accept instruction on how to apply God's solutions.

*Time:* 7-14 Days

## **LEVEL - 2 Freedom Discipleship**

*Objective:* Accept your responsibility to believe God's truth and learn to appropriate His Grace and forgiveness in your life.

*Assignments:* Memorize and recite Galatians 2.20-21 and Matthew 16.24-25 word perfect. Complete "The Life" video series with worksheets and discussions. All Level 1 assignments.

*Requirements:* Same as Level 1.

*Time:* 21 – 35 Days

## **LEVEL – 3 Personal Growths and Growth Setting**

*Objective:* To establish and implement personal and spiritual goals enabling you to experience continued growth and healing.

*Assignments:* Memorize and recite Proverbs 3.5-7 word perfect. Complete goal-setting worksheets. Schedule goal-setting session.

*Requirements:* Same as Level 1.

*Time:* 7 – 14 Days

# GENERAL RULES

- ❖ Everyone will perform their daily work schedules on time and with a good attitude.
- ❖ You are expected to maintain a kind and courteous attitude at all times.
- ❖ You will have different leaders working with you. Please remain cooperative. You must follow their instructions with out talking back.
- ❖ Smoking is not permitted while you are in the Lifeline Program. This is an intolerable offense resulting in immediate dismissal.
- ❖ You may not leave the Mission property while in the Lifeline Program.
- ❖ No ungodly conversation will be permitted.
- ❖ You will be required to maintain personnel daily hygiene including a shower daily.
- ❖ No clothing, food, or any other item is to be taken or used with out proper permission.
- ❖ Do not enter restricted areas with out permission, and/or supervision.
- ❖ If you are injured in any way while staying with us you are required to tell your leader immediately and fill out an incident report.
- ❖ If you have a problem or need assistance dealing with a leader or another program person please give a written request to the Program Director.
- ❖ You are required to take active part in all assigned Bible studies, Devotional guides, memory work, problem solving sheets and counseling sessions while in the Lifeline Program.
- ❖ Your weekly evaluations will reflect how you are progressing in the program take the time to read them, pray about them, and then ask questions.
- ❖ You will make mistakes in your daily walk. When God convicts you, it would be wise to correct the problem using the Biblical Problem Solving Worksheet and deal with the issue between you and the Lord. After you have completed the Worksheet you need to talk with a counselor immediately. The counselor may also require you to do a Biblical Problem Solving Worksheet in order to help you work through a problem.
- ❖ Phone calls and personal visits are not permitted while in the Lifeline program.
- ❖ No radios or cell phones permitted while in the Lifeline program.
