



Group Volunteer Opportunities

In addition to our numerous individual volunteer opportunities, Trinity Rescue Ministry has programs available for groups. These programs are based on the level of commitment each group would like to be responsible for. Groups must bring enough personnel to fulfill the required functions for their commitment level choice.

For instance, a group cannot request to be scheduled for commitment level 3 and only come with a speaker and a song leader, the responsibility for kitchen helpers would go unmet.

Commitment level 1 – Kitchen helpers or complete meal service only

Commitment level 2 – Kitchen helpers & Praise and Worship leaders

Commitment level 3 – Kitchen helpers, Praise and Worship leader(s) & Chapel speaker

Kitchen Helpers

Kitchen assistants help during dinner meal times offering serving, cleaning and hospitality assistance for our guests. Various positions include food line service, drink service, dish washing, after meal table clean-up, floor cleaning and guest seating. (5-8 people)

Complete meal Service

In addition to serving as kitchen helpers, groups are welcome to completely prepare a meal. The meal can be brought in or the group may cook what is on hand at the mission.

Praise and Worship leaders

Praise and Worship leaders are needed every night of the week. They lead in the congregational singing and offer musical specials. Praise and worship leaders may not offer or use music that does not uphold the Doctrinal positions of the Trinity Rescue Mission. Style is open to the discretion of the praise and worship leader; however, all music must seek to honor and glorify God in a controlled manner.

Chapel Speakers

Chapel speakers are needed every night of the week. Chapel speakers must read and sign a commitment to abide by the Doctrinal statement of Trinity Rescue Mission. Additionally, Chapel speakers are required to speak using the King James Version of the Bible.

Youth Group Volunteer Opportunities:

Trinity Rescue Mission stands in support of youth groups and organizations. In addition to being able to take advantage of the group volunteer opportunities above, we also encourage youth groups to sing, perform skits or provide other entertainment as is approved and appropriate.

Individual Volunteer Opportunities

Special Event Assistants

Trinity Rescue Mission has 5 annual events that require an increase in volunteer participation. These events include the Golf Tournament, Rescue Ride, Harvest Banquet, Thanksgiving and Christmas. These are 1 time annual commitments, however opportunities to participate in these events will be offered to regular volunteers first.

Clothing Attendants

Clothing Attendants are responsible for collecting, organizing and distributing donated clothing. Clothing Attendants will be assigned to their gender specific area.

Front Desk Coordinators

Front Desk Coordinators oversee the in-check of all guests, monitor all in-coming telephone calls, ensure all guests are read the facility rules and assign guests a Program Ambassador to move into the second phase of the in-check procedures.

Clinic Assistants

Clinic Assistants work with the clinic coordinator to streamline the in-check processing, scheduling and paperwork needs. Clinic Assistants are required to complete state mandated HIPPA training.

Playroom Assistants

Playroom Assistants help the Playroom Coordinator with various children's programs during adult meeting times and throughout the day. They also offer assistance for monitoring the playground area during approved play times. This position requires an extra level of security screening and is available to **female volunteers only**.

Program Ambassadors

Program Ambassador positions are available in both the men's and the women and children's facilities. They are in direct contact with the guests, providing tours and in-take processing. Program Ambassadors must be evangelistically skilled to present the Gospel in a variety of situations.

Covenant Sisters

Covenant Sisters offer mentorship for female program graduates. Once our graduates move from the mission to transitional or permanent housing, the covenant sisters offer counseling, advice, and discipleship. This additional assistance provides for a smoother transition back into society. Covenant Sister candidates must complete 6 months of volunteer service as a program ambassador before becoming a covenant sister.

Covenant Brothers

Covenant Brothers offer mentorship for male program graduates. Once our graduates move from the mission to transitional or permanent housing, the covenant brothers offer counseling, advice, and discipleship. This additional assistance provides for a smoother transition back into society. Covenant Brother candidates must complete 6 months of volunteer service as a program ambassador before becoming a covenant brother.
