Trinity Rescue Mission Exceeds \$43,000 in Designated Gifts To Maximize Feinstein Foundation Matching Grant

Donors of designated canned goods and money by area donors had their contributions doubled for an additional \$40,000.

Jacksonville, FL: The Trinity Rescue Mission of Jacksonville, FL concluded the \$40,000 matching gift challenge as part of the Feinstein Foundation's \$1,000,000 give-away to fight hunger. Over the past two months, donors have responded to the appeal for designated canned goods or financial contributions for a dollar-for-dollar match.

Trinity Rescue Mission's vision and track record of providing for the hungry, hurting and needy of Jacksonville, FL became a perfect fit into the Feinstein Foundation's annual give-away to fight hunger. In the past 11 consecutive years since Mr. Feinstein has offered it, over 3,000 participating agencies nationwide have used it to raise over \$800 million. It has become the most successful grassroots campaign to fight hunger ever.
