Trinity Rescue Mission Scheduled To Make Organic Produce Delivery To Clara White's School Of Culinary Arts

As the first crops come in from its organic farm in St. Johns County, TRM moves forward with its plan to supply produce for area service providers.

Jacksonville, FL: The Trinity Rescue Mission of Jacksonville, FL will make a delivery of 150lbs. of organic produce to Clara White's School of Culinary Arts (613 W. Ashley St.) on Tuesday, June 8, at 2pm. The organic produce is being supplied from Trinity's organic farm in St. Johns County. This delivery is from some of the first harvests at the Freedom Farm. Trinity officially launched its organic farming program in March of this year.

Jim Kilpatrick, Executive Director of Trinity Rescue Mission: "With these first deliveries of produce, the cycle of recovery is coming full-circle. Men who were once homeless and hungry are now restored and working to provide food for those in need. We are excited and supportive of Clara White Mission, led by it's director Ju'Coby Pittman, and the work they are doing with their School of Culinary Arts. We're thankful and blessed to be able to share this produce with them and hopefully many more great organizations in the future."

Trinity Rescue Mission has embraced this new initiative to meet the needs of the hungry in Northeast Florida, and to further its mission of providing a road to recovery for as many men, women and children as possible. The organic farming program is already under way, and once the program is operating at full capacity, it will produce enough organic produce to supply Trinity's mission downtown, as well as many of the other homeless shelters and food service providers in Jacksonville at no cost to them. The organic program has been given a strong start by the donation of a grant from the Sontag Foundation, and the materials for the shade houses have been donated by Reynolds Park Aluminum.
